



“IMPACT SPOTLIGHT”

Fiscal Year 2022

- **4,543** participants were served and **7,972** were impacted by UCAN
- **92%** of participants report overall satisfaction with UCAN and the services they received
- **94%** of participants say UCAN gave me the opportunity to improve my future
- **93%** of participants say UCAN helped me develop leadership skills
- **93%** of participants say UCAN helped me learn and grow

ACADEMY

- **82%** of student say UCAN connected me and/or children in my care to supportive, caring adults who help us achieve our goals

ALUMNI SERVICES

- **84** alumni were involved in activities and supports
- **100%** of youth said UCAN gave me the opportunity to improve my future

CHILD WELFARE

Foster Care:

- **96%** of youth in specialized foster care maintained the same placement for at least 12 months
- **89%** of youth in counseling made progress in mental health treatment
- **95%** of youth of are in school or working

Residential:

- **85%** of youth made progress in treatment

Teen Parent Service Network:

- **96%** of youth’s children received a developmental screening

MENTAL HEALTH

- **813** youth and families served by UCAN received mental health services
- **89%** of counseling participants made progress in treatment
- **97%** of youth say UCAN staff cares about me
- **96%** of youth say I feel comfortable to be/express myself

NORTH LAWNSDALE

- **163** North Lawnsdale youth/families received trauma-healing mental health services
- **68** Workplace Learning completions for North Lawnsdale youth and adults

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

- **235** youth participated in youth development groups
- **58** youth graduated the Diermeier Future Leaders Now program
- **97%** of youth say UCAN has helped them develop leadership skills
- **100%** of youth in DFLN feel more empowered to advocate for themselves or others

VIOLENCE INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION SERVICES

- **96%** youth and adults were not charged with a violent crime
- **884** Community mediations took place in the North Lawnsdale and Roseland Community

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- **181** youth and adults were placed in jobs
- **455** youth and adult completed a work-based learning program
